We, the athlete and the parents/and or guardians, understand and agree to:

- Attend all practices and games, unless we have a reasonable valid excuse such as illness or injury.
 - Agree to conduct ourselves in a sportsman like manner at all times towards our teammates, officials, coaches and opponents.
 - We understand that poor sportsmanship IS NOT acceptable and removal from the team may be the result.
 - Parents are responsible for transportation for their student athlete to and from practices, league games and events. Participation in the CSL requires traveling throughout Sonoma, Napa & Mendocino Counties.
 - It is the responsibility of the parents/guardians to have sufficient auto insurance when transporting your own/and or other participants to and from practices, league games and events.
 - A player must be present in school the day of a game, or the day before a Saturday game to be eligible to play.
 - Players must maintain a **2.0 average** in all academic areas throughout the season to be eligible to play.
 - The annual fee of **\$75.00 - 1st child, \$65.00 - 2nd child, \$50.00 - 3rd child** must be paid when you sign up. **(please make check payable to St. Francis Solano Athletic Dept.)**
 - It is the responsibility of the parents to make sure players do not remain on school grounds unsupervised, during non-practice hours.
- Participation in the CSL, by students and parents, is a privilege, not a right. The Catholic School League and its' representatives, reserve the right to remove those who fail to behave in a positive, responsible, Christian manner, from any league event. If such behavior is not resolved after notification to Athletic Director & School Administration, you may be asked to not attend any future CSL events.

MEDICAL RELEASE
